HISTOPATHOLOGY:

Slide 21, A2.3-45-1:

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney, adipose tissue, spleen, heart, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

Slide 22, A2.3-45-2:

1). Spleen, capsule: Peritonitis, moderate, focal, granulomatous, chronic

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney, adipose tissue, heart, brain (fragment), corpuscle of Stannius, pancreas, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

Slide 23, A2.3-45-3:

1). Spleen, capsule: Peritonitis, moderate, focal, granulomatous, chronic

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney, adipose tissue, heart, pancreas, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

Slide 24, A2.3-45-4:

1). Liver: Hemorrhage, mild to moderate, multifocal, acute

There are no overt lesions within the spleen, kidney, adipose tissue, heart, pancreas, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

Slide 25, A2.3-45-5:

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney, adipose tissue, spleen, heart, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

Slide 26, A2.3-45-6:

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney, adipose tissue, spleen, heart, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

COMMENTS:

In 2 of 6 section, there is a low to intermediate grade peritonitis which is consistent with a post vaccination response and likely would not have contributed significantly to antemortem morbidity. The liver hemorrhage in slide 24 is unusual and may be due artefact, trauma, an infectious etiology or some other disease process.
