HISTOPATHOLOGY:

Slide 3, A2.4-28-1:

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney, spleen, heart, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

Slide 4, A2.4-28-2:

- 1). Heart: Epicarditis, mild, focal, granulomatous, chronic
- 2). Spleen, capsule: Peritonitis, mild to moderate, focally extensive, granulomatous, chronic

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

Slide 5, A2.4-28-3:

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney, spleen, heart, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

COMMENTS:

In 1 of 3 slides, there is low grade granulomatous infiltrate suggestive of either a long past bacterial infection or possibly, resolving vaccine induced peritonitis. These nidi would not have contributed significantly to antemortem morbidity.
