HISTOPATHOLOGY:

Slide 6, A3.3-26-1:

1). Adipose tissue: Peritonitis, moderate, diffuse, granulomatous and fibrinous

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney, spleen, heart, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

Slide 7, A3.3-26-2:

1). Spleen: Peritonitis, mild, focal, granulomatous and fibrinous

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney, adipose tissue, heart, pancreas, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

Slide 8, A3.3-26-3:

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney, pancreas, spleen, heart, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

Slide 9, A3.3-26-4:

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney, pancreas, spleen, heart, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

COMMENTS:

In 2 of 4 sections, there are low grade localized peritonitis which likely would not have contributed significantly to antemortem morbidity; although this inflammatory infiltrate is most likely due to vaccination, the possibility of a long past bacterial infection cannot be entirely discounted. There were no other significant lesions within the examined tissues.
