HISTOPATHOLOGY:

Slide 89, A3.3-56-1:

There are no overt lesions within the peripheral nerve, spleen, heart, liver, peripheral vasculature or anterior kidney.

Slide 90, A3.3-56-2:

1). Heart: Epicarditis, mild, diffuse, granulomatous and fibrinous, subacute to chronic

There are no overt lesions within the spleen, liver, peripheral nerve, peripheral vasculature or anterior kidney.

Slide 91, A3.3-56-3:

There are no overt lesions within the pancreas, adipose tissue, peripheral nerve, spleen, heart, liver, peripheral vasculature or kidney.

Slide 92, A3.3-56-4:

1). Heart, endocardium: Endocarditis, mild to moderate, multifocal, subacute with reactive endocardia

There are no overt lesions within the peripheral nerve, spleen, liver, adipose tissue, peripheral vasculature, or kidney.

COMMENTS:

The endo- and epicarditis noted in slides 92 and 90, respectively are low to intermediate grade, non-specific and consistent with past inflammatory processes. The myocarditis in both sections would not have contributed significantly to impaired cardiovascular function. There were no other significant lesions within the examined tissues.
