1). Liver: Hepatitis, portal, mild, multifocal, lymphocytic, chronic

There are no overt lesions within the peripheral nerve, pancreas, adipose tissue, peripheral vasculature, heart, spleen, or kidney.

COMMENTS:

The chronic portal hepatitis is low grade and non specific. The infiltrate likely reflects a retrograde infection from the gastrointestinal track. There were no other discernible lesions within the examined tissues.
