**HISTOPATHOLOGY:**

Slide 27, A3-3-58-1:

There are no significant lesions within the heart, kidney, adipose tissue, peripheral vasculature, liver, peripheral nerves, or spleen.

Slide 28, A3-3-58-2:

1). Liver: Peliosis, moderate, multifocal, random, with endothelial mineral deposition

There are no significant lesions within the heart, adipose tissue, peripheral vasculature, peripheral nerves, or spleen.

**COMMENTS:**

The peliosis noted in slide 28 is unusual and likely would have contributed only mildly to antemortem morbidity; the precise pathogenesis and etiology of this condition is unknown. Although this condition has previously been associated with infectious agents, the lack of change within associated tissues suggests either an environmental (hypoxic), iatrogenic, metabolic or other disease entities.
