Wendy and Maia:

Please find attached a table describing the claims pursued by CCG for oil spill responses. Sergio has also supplied the following explanation:

Please note that CCG does not claim for all pollution incidents. The majority of incidents where CCG has deployed resources either as the On-Scene Commander or Federal Monitoring Officer have been relatively minor and have not been cost recovered. This is due mainly because it is felt that the cost of preparing, submitting and collecting a claim for these minor incidents would be far more than the amount of the claim.

Pursuant to the *Marine Liability Act*, CCG claims for costs and expenses from the shipowner and/or the Ship-source Oil Pollution Fund (SOPF). When the CCG presents a claim and receives settlement from the SOPF, the SOPF steps in CCG's shoes (subrogated rights) and pursues the shipowner.

The attached table summarizes the CCG's cost recovery activities for Pacific Region from 2005 to the present. In investigating and settling CCG claims, the SOPF has a duty to ensure that all measures and costs are "reasonable". In the table, the "Unrecovered" column represents the portion of the claim that the SOPF felt was not reasonable and therefore not established nor paid.
