Dear Dr. Kibenge

I have no idea where Hon D McRae got his information from. We informed the Chief Veterinary Officers and the Fisheries and Aquaculture Ministries in the provinces and territories that we received 2 notifications from AVC, one involving the detection and one involving suspicion of ISAV and that we are investigating: acquiring and assessing epidemiological and clinical information and identifying whether original samples are available to be tested by the National Aquatic Animal Health Laboratory System.

I should advise you that your laboratory report that was sent back to SFU, which appears to be the OIE notification you sent to Dr. Evans for approval for submission to the OIE, is available on a public web site.
