Keen recreational fisherman since my youth.

Worked as a fishing guide at Painter's Lodge, Campbell River, BC, summers 1974, 1975, 1977, & 1978.

Self-employed fishing guide May to October, 1979 to present.

DFO certified Fish Culture Technician, I work seasonally at the DFO Quinsam hatchery near Campbell River, fall crew X 8 weeks, 1996 to present; spring crew X 8 weeks, 2009 & 2010.

Active in area recreational fishing organizations (Steelhead Society of BC, Tyee Club of BC, Campbell River Guides Association, Sport Fishing Institute of BC), have been a director in all of them for periods of time.

Became involved in the Campbell River branch of the Sport Fishing Advisory Board in the early 1980's, continue to present.

Became further involved in the broader SFAB process, was chairman 1997 – 2007. Am currently chair of the SFAB Chinook & Coho and Aquaculture working groups and remain on the SFAB executive.

Appointed to the Canadian delegation, Pacific Salmon Commission on the Southern Panel, December 1999 to present.

Became a recreational fishery representative to the Integrated Harvest Planning Committee, DFO, at its inception (2003?) to present. As such I participated in the Williams Inquiry into Fraser Sockeye salmon, winter 2003/2004.

Appointed to the Pacific Salmon Forum, December 2004. A provincial initiative chaired by the Hon. John Fraser, report made public February 2009.
