Another aspect of the DFO that causes great concern: It is their new draft aquaculture regulations which appear by various means to be aimed at giving themselves and the fish farm companies an immunity from those laws safeguarding the wild which other citizens have to regard.

This and other dangerous flaws have been pointed out in detail by Georgia Strait Alliance and others.

I think clarity and definition are prerequisites in law. If in DFO's draft there is much that is ambiguous and unclear instead of the transparency they profess, perhaps it's there as a camouflage.
